Verify the system requirements

software version	<p>This hotfix works with BlackBerry® Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 for Microsoft® Exchange.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On the taskbar, click Start > Settings > Control Panel. 2. Double-click Add/Remove Programs. 3. In the list of currently installed programs, click BlackBerry Enterprise Server. 4. Click Support Information. 5. Verify that the version number is 4.1.3 (Bundle 37 or 43).
remote components	<p>Install this hotfix only on computers where the BlackBerry MDS Services, BlackBerry Collaboration Service, or the BlackBerry MDS Connection Service resides.</p>
original installation media	<p>The hotfix installation program requires access to the installation media that was used to install the BlackBerry Enterprise Server. Depending on how the software was installed, this might be a product CD or a network location.</p>

Install the hotfix

1. While logged in to the BlackBerry Enterprise Server computer, double-click **besx413hf2.zip**.
2. Extract the setup program files to the local drive on your computer.
3. Browse to the location of the setup program files.
4. Double-click **besx413hf2.msp**.
5. Click **Update**.
6. Complete the configuration screens.
7. Click **Finish**.

Verify the hotfix installation

1. On the taskbar, click **Start > Settings > Control Panel**.
2. Click **Add/Remove Programs**.
3. In the list of programs, click **BlackBerry Enterprise Server**.
4. Click **Support Information**.
5. Verify that the version number is 4.1.3 Hotfix 2 (Bundle 61).

Fixed issues

Issues that are marked with an asterisk (*) are fixed in this hotfix release. All other issues were fixed in previous hotfix releases.

BlackBerry Instant Messaging for Microsoft Live Communications Server

SDR 115964 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, if a user with a Microsoft® Office Communicator client updated the presence status in the calendar, the BlackBerry device threw an exception when viewing the contact information.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF1 and later, this issue is resolved.

BlackBerry MDS Services

*SDR 122252 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, when verbose logging was enabled, some HTTPS information was written to the log files.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF2 and later, this issue is resolved.

SDR 117384 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, in certain circumstances, if a user attempted to load a web page with a malformed .png image, the BlackBerry MDS Services stopped responding.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF1 and later, this issue is resolved.

BlackBerry MDS Studio Application repository

SDR 119459 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, if a BlackBerry MDS Studio Application did not include a required encoding style namespace in an element, the BlackBerry MDS Studio Application did not start.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF1 and later, this issue is resolved.

BlackBerry Messaging Agent

*SDR 122986 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, when hosting a BlackBerry Enterprise Server and using Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP) for address lookup, the address lookup failed.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF2 and later, this issue is resolved.

*SDR 119351 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, if S/MIME message processing is turned on, when processing a large S/MIME encrypted or signed message that contains an attachment, the BlackBerry Enterprise Server CPU usage might increase to 100 percent.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF2 and later, this issue is resolved.

Wireless synchronization

*SDR 126644 In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3, in certain circumstances, when you applied Microsoft Security Bulletin MS07-013, task information no longer showed up properly.
In BlackBerry Enterprise Server Version 4.1 SP3 HF2 and later, this issue is resolved.
