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About the Social Feeds application

With the Social Feeds application, you can stay up-to-date with your social networks and receive the latest news and information from your favorite blogs and websites in one location.

In the Social view, you can view updated feeds from your social applications, as well as your instant messaging applications. You can also post updates to your social networks and update your instant messaging statuses.

In the News view, you can read RSS web feeds and blogs, and view full feed items in the browser. You can also create views and search your feeds by keyword.

Social application feeds

View feed items by social application

1. In the **Social** view, click the navigation bar at the top of the screen.
2. Click a social application.
 - To view all of the feed items from another social application, scroll left or right on the navigation bar at the top of the screen.
 - To view feed items from all social applications again, click the navigation bar at the top of the screen. Click **All Social items**.

View a social feed item

To view a feed item in the social application that it is from, in the **Social** view, click a feed item.

Post an update to your social applications

You can post an update to multiple social applications simultaneously.

1. Press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **New Post**.
3. Click the social applications that you want to post to.
4. Type an update.
5. Click the **Post** icon.

RSS feeds

Add an RSS feed

You can add an RSS feed by typing the web address of the RSS feed. You can also search a web site for any available RSS feeds by typing the web address of the web site.

1. In the **News** view, press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **New RSS Feed**.
3. Type a web address of an RSS feed or a web site.
4. Click **Next**.
5. Select the check box beside each feed that you want to add.
6. Click **Subscribe**.

Add an RSS feed from the browser

1. In the browser, on a web page with an RSS feed, press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Subscribe to RSS Feed**.
3. Select the check box beside each feed that you want to add.
4. Click **Subscribe**.
5. Click **OK**.

Stop receiving items from an RSS feed

When you stop receiving items from an RSS feed, the RSS feed remains on the **Manage RSS Feeds** screen and is not deleted.

1. In the **News** view, press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Manage RSS Feeds**.
3. Highlight a news feed.
4. Press the **Menu** key.
5. Click **Unsubscribe**.

To start receiving items from the news feed again, complete steps 1 to 4. Click **Subscribe**.

Delete an RSS feed

1. In the **News** view, press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Manage RSS Feeds**.
3. Highlight a feed.

4. Press the **Menu** key.
5. Click **Delete**.
6. Click **Yes**.

View an RSS feed item

1. In the **News** view, click a feed item.
2. To view the full feed item in the browser, click **View Full Story**.

Revert to the default RSS feeds

Your wireless service provider might have provided you some default RSS feeds.

Note: When you revert to the default RSS feeds, the RSS feeds that you added are deleted.

1. Press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Options**.
3. Click **RSS Options**.
4. Click **Revert to Default Subscriptions**.

Post an RSS feed item as an update to your social applications

You can post a link to an RSS feed item, such as a blog post or news story, to your social applications.

1. In the **News** view, highlight a feed item.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Post Link**.
4. Click the social applications that you want to post to.
5. Type a post.
6. Click the **Post** icon.

Change your RSS feed options

1. Press the **Menu** key > **Options**.
2. Click **RSS Options**.
3. Complete the instructions on the screen to change your feed options.
4. Press the **Menu** key > **Save**.

Customizing feeds and views

Create a new view

You can create a new view to keep up-to-date with only the people and information you choose.

1. Press the **Menu** key > **New View**.
2. Type a name for the new view.
3. To receive a notification on the device home screen when new items are available, select the **Notify me of new items** check box.
4. Click **Add item**.
 - To add updates from a person, click **A User**. Select the checkbox beside each person you want to include in your new view. Click **Apply**.
 - To add an RSS feed, click **RSS feed**. Select the checkbox beside each RSS feed you want to include in your new view. Click **Apply**.
 - To add feed items that include specific keywords, click **Search Term**. Type a keyword. Click **Apply**.
5. Click **Create**.

To edit the view, press the **Menu** key > **Edit View**.

Add a person or RSS feed to a view

1. In the **Social** or **News** views, highlight a feed item.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Watch <person or feed> in**.
4. Click a view.

Add a feed item to the Bookmarks view

You can bookmark specific updates from your social applications or feed items from your RSS feeds.

1. Highlight a feed item.
2. Press the **Menu** key > **Add Bookmark**.

Feed options

Search your feeds

1. Press the **Menu** key > **Search**.
2. Type a keyword.

To change the scope of your search, click the **Change Criteria** icon beside the search field.

Change your feed display options

1. Press the **Menu** key > **Options**.
 - To stop receiving feed items from a feed, click **Integrated Applications**. Clear the checkbox beside a social application.
 - To change how many lines of text each feed item displays, click **Display**. Change the **Row Height** field.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Save**.

Change your notification options

1. Press the **Menu** key > **Options**.
2. Click **Notifications**.
3. Select the checkbox beside each view that you want to receive notifications from.
4. Press the **Menu** key > **Save**.

Refresh your feeds

You can refresh both your social application feeds and your RSS feeds.

1. Press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Refresh**.

Check for the latest version of the Social Feeds application

1. Press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Options**.
3. Click **Software Update**.
