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# What's new in AtHoc Geofencing 1.0?

## New AtHoc Geofencing App

AtHoc Geofencing is a standalone application that enables operators to accurately and easily track the location of users in the field. Using AtHoc Geofencing, operators can easily identify where a user currently is, where they've been, and how long they've been there. AtHoc Geofencing provides automated entry and exit tracking, giving the operator greater situational awareness of their users.

- Select `IsGeofencingAppSupported` in feature enablement to enable the new AtHoc Geofencing App.
- Create, edit, and delete geofences to define locations of interest.
- Create a geofence by drawing or selecting a predefined shape on the map, entering a name, and targeting individual users and distribution lists.
- Access dwelling reports to view the entry, exit, and dwelling times of tracked users in a geofence.
- View dwelling reports for one or all geofences.
- Export dwelling reports to a CSV file.
- Control access to the geofencing application to operators with one of the following roles: Enterprise Administrator, Organization Administrator or Geofence Manager.

# Known issues

AB-2473	The Geofence API does not display an error when an organization is not registered for the Geofence service.	—
<b>Dwelling reports</b>		
AB-2472	Sorting does not work for the Dwelling Time column on the Dwelling Report screen.	—
AB-2480	If the name of a geofence is edited, entries in the dwelling report prior to the name change do not display the new geofence name.	—
IWS-69393	The Entry Time and Exit Time fields on the Dwelling Report screen should be labelled Entry Timestamp and Exit Timestamp	—
IWS-69607	If a special character that does not appear in any geofence name is entered in the Search field on the Dwelling Report screen, all geofences are displayed.	—
<b>Search</b>		
IWS-69399	If a '\' character is entered in the search field on the Add Users dialog, a HTTPS 400 error is displayed.	—
<b>Tracked Users</b>		
AB-2514	Users who are added to a geofence and then are then disabled, moved, or deleted in BlackBerry AtHoc still appear in the Tracked Users section of the geofence.	—
IWS-69592	Distribution lists are not displayed in alphabetical order in the pull-down menu in the Tracked Users section. Roles are not displayed in alphabetical order on the Roles column on the Add Users dialog.	—
