What's new in BlackBerry Guard

Managed XDR capabilities : BlackBerry Guard supports managed extended detection and response (XDR) capabilities to unify relevant endpoint detections from BlackBerry UES products and third-party applications.

Integration with BlackBerry UES products: BlackBerry Protect, BlackBerry Optics, BlackBerry Persona, and BlackBerry Gateway are integrated with BlackBerry Guard, allowing analysts to utilize the various data collected from endpoints to protect and prevent against malicious attacks.

Integration with third-party applications: Integrating third-party applications (such as Exabeam) allows you to quickly equip Guard analysts with the security features and tools that meets the needs of your organization. When these applications are integrated, you enable holistic telemetry and cross-tool hunting capabilities, visible from a unified console.

Multi-region support: BlackBerry Guard supports multi-regional architecture to ensure that your organization complies with regional data regulations such as General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Supported regions include APAC, EMEA, LATAM, and NA regions.

New user experience: The BlackBerry Guard portal has a new UI look and feel. It features a simple and unified view of alerts and interactive chat ability with Guard analysts.
